

SCIENCE

THEME: WAR AND PEACE OF WORLD

By analysing the science behind of "War and Peace," learners can gain a deeper appreciation for the impact of technology on battlefield outcomes.

Conduct a research work on the following given topic and write down a report on the given format.

- a) Use A-4 sheets
- b) Compile the sheets in a file folder.
- c) Support your project by pasting relevant pictures.

1. (Roll no. - 1 to 10)

"War and Peace." Analyse the consequences of the chemicals involved in warfare during the time period of War. Research the impact and the outcomes of battles during the Napoleonic Wars and the alternates to these consequences and situations. What are the steps to be taken to reduce the impacts of destruction on nature and mankind during war.

2. (Roll no. – 11 to 20)

Explore the role of chemistry in medicine during the 19th century, a time period when advancements in pharmaceuticals and medical treatments were beginning to emerge. Research the development of new drugs, surgical techniques, and medical discoveries during this era of War.

3. (Roll no. – 21 to Last)

Explore the chemistry of materials used in construction of buildings, forts and castles involved in warfare during the time period of War. Research the chemical properties of these materials, their manufacturing processes, and how these were applicable in military fortifications.
