LIFE SKILLS ACTIVITIES

- > Laying the shoe rack: Take help from the elder, clean your shoes properly and keep it well organized in your rack.










SOCIAL SKILLS ACTIVITIES

- ➤ Encourage your child to converse freely with family members and friends.
- ➤ Encourage your child to speak magical words like 'Thank you', 'Please', 'Excuse me', 'May l' and 'Sorry'.

- > WORKSHEET BOOK: Complete the worksheets 25, 26, 27 & 28 of worksheet book.










MATH
