So, parents, let them put their thinking caps & get their imagination going. Please download the Worksheets & Activities. Let us all help them be more confident & independent...








# EXPLOPING REAPING CREATIVE THINKING






## **Creative Writing-Based Questions:**

- 3. Imagine you planted a tree. What would it look like? What would you do to help it grow? (Promotes awareness about plants and care for the environment.)
- 4. What do you see when you go to the park? Write 3 things. (Relates to nature and surroundings.)
- If you could travel in any vehicle, which one would you choose and why? (Connects to transport and creative thinking.)







## **Exploration Questions**

1.Touch the bark of a tree. Is it rough or smooth? What color is it?

(Encourages sensory observation and nature connection.)

- Look at the sky during the day. What do you see? Draw it. (Develops awareness of natural elements like clouds, sun, or birds.)
- 3. Check your lunchbox. Which foods come from plants and which come from animals?

(Teaches origin of food in a practical way.)

4. Stand near a plant in the morning. Can you see any insects? What are they doing?


(Encourages noticing life around plants and pollinators.)


5. Feel the wind on your face. Is it strong, soft, or not blowing at all? What does it make move?

(Promotes eco-friendly thinking and innovation.)



## **Dancing Figures**


1pc cube or 1pc
