




Get ready to embark on this journey by following the given instructions:

3. Make a POSTER of any one famous Indian mathematician using newspaper cuttings, images, slogans, quotes etc. on a A3 sheet.


















Our history is a reflection of our rich cultural heritage. Cultural heritage is the legacy of cultural resources and intangible attributes of a group or society that is inherited from past generations.



Note: These a Foil Art Craft is a fun, shiny, and easy craft technique that uses aluminium foil as the main surface or decorative element. It's perfect for kids and adults alike and can be customized in countless creative ways!

Foil Art Craft: Basic Technique

Materials Needed:

- · Aluminium foil (kitchen foil)
- Cardboard or thick paper as a base
- Black marker or permanent markers
- Glue (white glue or glue stick)
- Cotton swabs or soft cloth (for blending, if colouring)
- Optional: Yarn, string, puffy paint, or hot glue (for textured designs)

Method: Textured Foil Art (More Advanced)

- 1. Draw a Design on Cardboard:
- o Sketch a flower, abstract design, or name.
- 2. Trace with Yarn or Puffy Paint:
- o Glue yarn or use puffy paint over the design lines and let dry completely.
- 3. Cover with Foil:
- o Gently press foil over the raised design, shiny side out.
- o Smooth carefully with fingers or a soft cloth to reveal the texture.
- 4. Colour the Raised Design (Optional):
- o Use markers or shoe polish to colour and antique the surface.
