Also, add a small paragraph discussing how human language and expression have evolved with each generation.

Interview two people from different generations (e.g., your grandparents and a teenager today) using the same 5–7 questions on topics like communication, daily routine, school life, or entertainment.

Create a comparison table or paragraph showing the similarities and differences in their responses.

#### 4. Lifestyle Then vs Now

Create a page showing how daily lifestyle habits have changed over time. You can include changes in:

- Clothing
- Food habits
- Travel
- Schooling
- Family time

Use pictures, small write-ups, or drawings to make it visually engaging.





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#### 5. Fun Corner!

Design a fun section that includes at least three of the following:

- Crossword
- Riddles or jokes
- Sketches/drawings



3. Human Circulatory System\*: Design a model using pipes, tubes, or straws, illustrating the heart, arteries, veins, and blood vessels.

(For Roll no 22 onwards)

4. Human Excretory System\*: Create a model using clay, cardboard, or paper mache, labeling each part (kidneys, ureters, bladder, urethra).

- Paper mache or papier-mâché
- Plastic bottles or containers
- Straws or tubes

#### Project Title: "Fold & Reuse - Newspaper Craft"

**Objectives:** 

- 1. Encourage recycling and reduce paper waste
- 2. Improve handcraft and creativity skills
- 3. Promote sustainability through art

#### What You Can Make:

Choose one or more of the following:

1.A newspaper basket (can be used for holding stationery, fruits, or gifts)

2.Pen stand

- 3.Wall hanging or photo frame
- 4.Coasters or mats
- 5.Decorative tray or box

**Materials Needed:** 

Old newspapers or magazines, Glue or Fevicol, Scissors, Paint (optional), Cardboard (for base, if needed) Ruler and pencil

#### **Basic Method (for a Basket):**

- 1. Roll strips of newspaper tightly to form paper sticks.
- 2. Weave them using a basket-weaving technique.
- 3. Create a base and then build the sides by folding or layering.
- 4. Secure with glue and let it dry.
- 5. Paint or decorate (optional).

- 3. Pictures can be paste both the sides because it is revolving and kindly attach ribbons of half centimeter for placing the images on separate sheets as per image
- 4. Make beautiful 3D Rose flowers from colourful ribbons , pastel papers , foam sheets etc . Place beautiful thread or thin ribbon for hanging .
